1. They are adults.

What do they want when they are learning?

1. A immediate success (*they can successfully solve their problems*)
2. to apply their experiences in the learning process.
3. to prefer self-pace learning (*learning by their experiences, entry level, time available*).

What they do NOT want?

1. Risks (*the learned knowledge and skills can not be applied*).
2. Theoretical subjects
3. learning in affected environment

What are the differences?



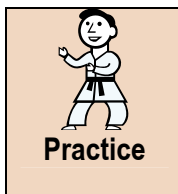
The adult learning is learning and teaching activities oriented to solving (learning) problems of the adults.



The children learning is learning and teaching activities aimed at general education for children.

What are the main features of the adult learning/training?

- **Problem solving**
- **Master/skills-oriented** (for adults)
- **Small group and/or individual leaning**
- **Integration between theories and practices (traing content) and content and methods**
- **Suitable for self-learning**
- **Application of self-assessment of learning achievements.**
